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## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The candidate for the Early Childhood Credential holds a minimum of a bachelor’s degree from an accredited institution. An Associate Early Childhood Credential may be given to students who do not have a 4-year college degree. Candidates for the Associate Early Childhood Credential must complete all requirements for the program in which they are enrolled. Teachers with an Associate Credential are eligible for the Early Childhood Credential when the 4-year college degree requirement has been completed and an official college transcript is sent to the certifying agency.
